LOWER BAY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT
- CONSTRUCTION START -

At their meeting held on July 11, 2018, the Board of Selectmen signed a construction contract with John H. Lyman and Sons, Inc., the General Contractor who will be responsible for the reconstruction of approximately 4,500 linear feet of Lower Bay Road in Sanbornton. The Board also signed a construction engineering contract with Holden Transportation Engineering to oversee the field work and provide administrative services during the construction of this project.

The current schedule has the contractor beginning his work on July 23, 2018, and extending into early November of this year. At that the point, the project will be shut down for the winter. Road users will be travelling on a paved surface (called winter binder) through the winter months of 2018-2019. In the Spring of 2019, the general contractor will return for final paving (called wearing course), and complete final cleanup items which will bring the project to 100% completion.

Through the course of the project construction, residents of Lower Bay Road and other road users are encouraged to view a project Website on a daily basis for specific details regarding the contractor's segmental approach to the construction process. On a daily basis, the Website will be updated to show specific work areas (by reference to street address numbers) so that locals can plan their travel patterns to avoid the busy construction zones.
